## Frequently Asked Questions Concerning E-Learning Modules

Question: Do I have to complete E-Learning in a specific order?

<u>Answer:</u> We encourage sticking to the recommended order in this table to take your e-learning modulesto avoid any issue with some courses requiring a prerequisite course.

Question: I did not pass my assessment, what now?

**Answer:** That is okay! Wait 1 or 2 days before tryingto take the assessment again.

Question: My passing score has not been recorded, what should I do?

**Answer:** If you did not complete the assessment within the 90-minute timeframe, please retake the assessment.

- 1. If you completed the assessment within the 90-minute timeframe, take a full-screen capture of your passing assessment with the grade. Save it. It usually takes 3 or 4 days for a passing score to be recorded. Check again at a later time.
- 2. If it has been more than 72 hours since taking your assessment and the system is still not showing your passing grade, ask your instructor for help. Send your instructor the screen capture. It will be very helpful for your instructor to provide it to the TECS support team when asking for assistance.
